



## Important notes:

- Use the tracking code to track your application online.
- It may take up to 10 days for a response to your application.
- If your visa type is not available online, please contact the embassy.
- Inaccurate or incomplete information may result in the application being rejected.
- After receiving your visa and insurance document, print them and keep them with you throughout your travel.



- The e-visa is not affixed to the passport, nor is it stamped upon entry and exit.
- If the visa application is submitted through the embassy, an additional **20 euros** will be added to the visa application fee.
- The validity period of a single-entry visa to Iran is **45 days** from the date of issuance.
- The permitted length of stay in Iran, subject to the approval of the Iranian party, ranges from two to **90 days**.



### Required Documents (in JPG format):

- 1 A passport-sized photo with a white background (400 x 600 pixels, less than 500 KB)
- 2 A photo of the first page of your passport (valid for at least 6 months, 600 x 800 pixels, less than 500 KB)

### Access the website:

- 2 Go to: [evisa.mfa.ir](http://evisa.mfa.ir) and select the "Submit Visa Application" option.

### Complete the online form:

- 3 Accurately enter your personal information in Algeria and your place of residence in Iran.

### Email Confirmation:

- 4 A code will be sent to your email. Enter it to confirm your final registration.

### Get a tracking code and barcode:

- 5 After successful registration, you will receive a tracking code to track your order.

### Application Review:

- 6 You may be asked to submit additional documents or appear at the embassy if necessary.

### Submitting your passport to the embassy:

- 7 After final approval, submit your passport to the Iranian consulate or embassy.

### Payment of fees:

- 8 Visa and travel insurance fees are paid via Algeria Post (CCP).

### Receive your visa by email:

- 9 You will receive your visa and insurance policy via email for printing.
